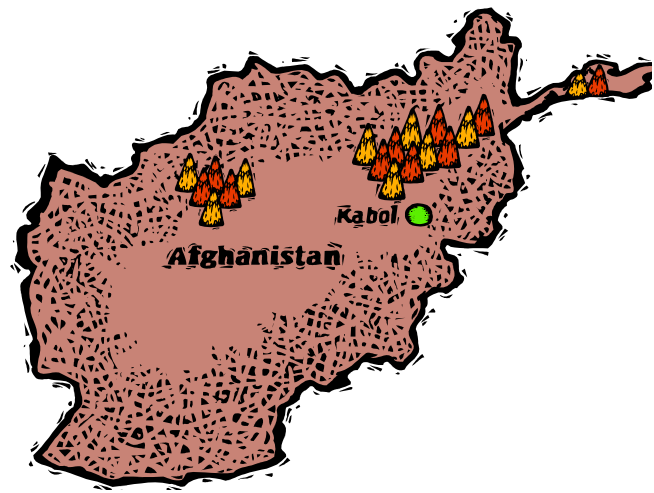


Reflections on Teacher Education in Afghanistan
